WHEREAS, the Prince William County Planning Commission has held four work sessions to discuss the process to complete the preparation and recommendation of changes to the Comprehensive Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Prince William County Planning Commission does hereby initiate the incremental review and update of the Comprehensive Plan, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the first review and update be a technical update to the Comprehensive Plan to include an update of the demographic data and to make corrections, updates and changes to the goals, objectives, action strategies, and maps based on changed circumstances, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the second review and update address the Transportation policies of the Comprehensive Plan to bring the Plan into conformance with the Code of Virginia that mandates inclusion of certain information regarding the extent and cost of transportation and road improvements in the plan, to update the Thoroughfare Plan and transportation level of service standards based on updated demographic information, and to make technical amendments to keep the Plan consistent with other County, regional, and state transportation documents, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the third review and update address land use and housing to align the Long Range Land Use Plan with the County's growth management and smart growth objectives as they relate to type, location, and density of land uses, and to bring the Plan into conformance with the Code of Virginia that mandates inclusion of affordable housing strategies, and to include strategies to encourage developers to provide affordable housing as a percentage of their project, and
